

## Main Sports Camp Candidate Sites

### ① Kose Sports Park | Kofu City | 840, Kosemachi, Kofu City, Yamanashi



Located in the central area of Kofu city, it is the base of athletic activities in the prefecture as a comprehensive athletic facility with an athletic field, gymnasium, martial arts stadium, swimming area, and training facility. The athletic field is the largest in Yamanashi, and is being used as the home stadium of the J. League football team, VENTFORET KOFU, and official games of the Japanese Rugby League. The gymnasium and martial arts stadium meet the IF standards. With experiences of holding various games, these facilities are prepared to support and provide optimum training programs for up-coming games.

### Athletic Field



This is a JAAF Class 1 certified athletic field. Official 100m run can be held at not only the homestretch but also backstretch, providing suitable training depending on the wind direction.

400m track: 8 Lanes, All-weather urethane pavement

In-field: 106 x 69m, Natural turf (1 field : football, rugby)

Nighttime lighting (200 - 1500 Lx)

### Gymnasium



This is used for domestic league games of volleyball and basketball. Both main arena and sub-arena are equipped with air conditioning, offering pleasant training environment throughout a year.

### Martial Arts Stadium



The spring mechanism designed for competition is built into the flooring of 1st and 2nd martial arts fields. All buildings are equipped with air conditioning, and it offers a comfortable training environment throughout a year.

### ③ YBP (Yuta's Bike Park) | Hokuto City | 1823, Koarama, Nagasaka Town, Hokuto City, Yamanashi



This is the only domestic BMX course that meets the international standards. The start hill with its height of 8m has the same height as found in the world class games such as an Olympic games. There is a dirt jump course for professionals and is also special course where the top ranked professionals practice.

### ④ Hokuto City Civic Gymnasium (Hakushu) | Hokuto City | 2913-208, Torihara, Hakushu-cho, Hokuto City, Yamanashi



As being located at a higher land with the elevation of approx. 700m, cooler climate makes summer training pleasant.

## ② Fuji Hokuroku Park | Fujiyoshida City | 5000, Kamiyoshida-Tateishi, Fujiyoshida City, Yamanashi



Being located on 1,035m above sea level and the northern area of Mt. Fuji, this is a comprehensive sports park featuring the athletic field, ball game field (natural turf), gymnasium, ball stadium, and training facility. Being surrounded by beautiful nature, cool climate makes summer training pleasant. Fields are made with high quality turf. In fact, they are the same kind used in Tokyo Stadium (site for Rugby World Cup 2019 Japan and Rugby in 2020 Tokyo Olympics) and International Stadium Yokohama (site for FIFA World Cup 2002 final and Rugby World Cup 2019 Japan), so they provide optimum training environment for up-coming games. These facilities are used for training camps and official games for athletics, including training camps for FIFA World Cup in 2002 and the Japan Athletic Team for World Championships.

### Athletic Field



This is a JAAF Class 2 certified athletic field. The view of Mt. Fuji is visible from the starting line of 100m. The indoor practice lane, weight training facility, and nighttime lights will be installed by 2018.

400m track: 8 lanes, All-weather urethane pavement

## ⑤ Midai-minami Park Rugby Stadium | Minami-Alps City | 1588-2, Mujina, Minami-Alps City, Yamanashi



It is the only rugby stadium in Yamanashi, and is used for official games and practice. The fields are well maintained throughout a year.

## ⑥ Shirane High School Second Ground Hockey Field | Minami-Alps City | 850-1, Kamiimasuwa, Minami-Alps City, Yamanashi



It was used as a hockey game field during the Inter-High School Championships in 2014. The "water base" is used for artificial turf and the specifications are the same as the game field during the London Olympics, and meets the global standards introduced by the International Hockey League.

## 7 Yamanashi Gakuin University | Kofu City | 2-4-5, Sakaori, Kofu City, Yamanashi



There are various sports facilities located inside the university campus, such as the athletic field, Judojo, wrestling arena, hockey stadium, rugby field, tennis court, swimming pool, football field, and college sports center, providing comprehensive training facility.

### 【Jutoku-kan】

The spring mechanism designed for competition purpose is built into the flooring.

Air conditioning is available in the facility, offering comfortable training environment throughout a year.

It was used as training camp for national Judo and wrestling teams in the past.

## 8 Hikawa High School Weightlifting Gym

Yamanashi City | 1062, Icchotanaka, Yamanashi City, Yamanashi



The floor in the weightlifting gym is spacious, and sets of barbells that meet the international standards are provided. The facility provides the top class training environment in Japan. The facility has a higher ceiling to prevent heat from being accumulated.

## 9 Shikishima Sogo Park Multi-Purpose Athletic Field

With a view of Mt. Fuji and surrounded by a nature rich area, it has a natural turf ground. The National Athletic Meet Archery Competition was held here.

## 10 Lake Kawaguchiko Boat Rowing Course

Fujikawaguchiko Town | 3131, Kawaguchi, Fujikawaguchiko Town, Minamitsuru-gun, Yamanashi



It is a boat rowing course located at Lake Kawaguchiko with the elevation of approx. 800m over the foot of Mt. Fuji. Great nature surrounding the area makes summer training pleasant.

1,000m, 6 lanes

## 11 Lake Shojiko Canoe Course

Fujikawaguchiko Town | 483-14-banchisaki, Shoji, Fujikawaguchiko Town, Minamitsuru-gun, Yamanashi



It is a canoe course located at Lake Shojiko with the elevation of approx. 900m over the foot of Mt. Fuji. Great nature surrounding the area makes summer training pleasant.

## 12 Kunugidaira Football Field

Fujikawaguchiko Town | 6816-2, Kodachi, Fujikawaguchiko Town, Minamitsuru-gun, Yamanashi



It is a football specialized stadium located at the elevation of approx. 1,100m over the foot of Mt. Fuji. At the superb location with a view of majestic Mt. Fuji, training will be available in a cooler environment even in summer. The Cameroon National Team for FIFA World Cup 2002 used during their training camp.

## 13 Motosuko Sports Center

Fujikawaguchiko Town | 210, Motosu, Fujikawaguchiko Town, Minamitsuru-gun, Yamanashi



It is a complex type sports facility located by the lakeside of Lake Motosuko that has been remodeled and reopened in July 2016. Around the all weather type athletic field at the center, there are a full pitch football field, the gymnasium, and accommodation building. Cool climate makes summer training pleasant.

## 14 Lake Motosuko

Fujikawaguchiko Town | 210-banchisaki, Motosu, Fujikawaguchiko Town, Minamitsuru-gun, Yamanashi



It is a boat rowing course located at Lake Motosuko with the elevation of approx. 900m over the foot of Mt. Fuji. The World Junior Canoe Championship was held in the past. Since it is a natural lake, not an artificial lake, it is not affected by a lake level variation, and effects of wind and wave are minimum, so it is ideal for practice. Great nature surrounding the area makes summer training pleasant.

## 15 Yamanakako Communication Plaza KIRARA

Yamanakako Village | 479-2, Hirano, Yamanakako Village, Minamitsuru-gun, Yamanashi



It is a multi-purpose park facility utilizing a rich natural environment of Lake Yamanakako. Located 1,000m over the foot of Mt. Fuji. The net between the two wide fields, the clay ground and the natural turf ground can be removed and will provide the maximum 230m wide open field, meeting the IF standards of archery competition, providing training environment of real competition.

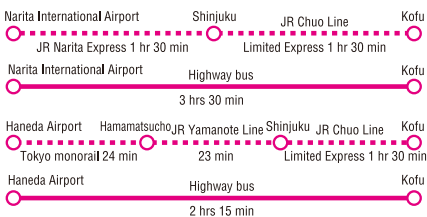

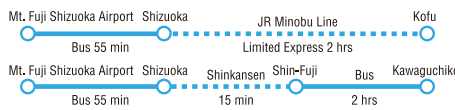

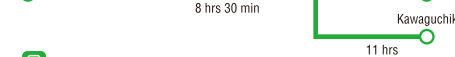
